SUZIE UNGERLEIDER SHARES NEW SINGLE 'JUNIPER'

Today, Canadian singer-songwriter **Suzie Ungerleider** releases her new single, 'Juniper', taken from her upcoming eleventh album, ***Among the Evergreens***, which also includes previously released tracks '[The Wilds](#)', '[Sirens](#)', and '[Real Estate](#)' and is set for release on June 6, 2025, via MVKA. Written as a gift to her husband for their 20th anniversary, the song is accompanied by a charming lyric video that portrays the couple's enduring sense of fun.

Full of summer nostalgia, 'Juniper' captures the rush of young love and long-distance romance. With tambourine and shimmering 12-string electric guitar, Suzie paints a vivid scene of green valleys, top-down drives, and tender moments in a red Chevy Blazer. 'Juniper' is a heartfelt highlight from a collection rooted in her return to Vancouver's evergreen beauty.

The new album is divided into two parts: "Then" and "Now" – songs inspired by the past and by the present. Suzie reflects on what it means to be in the middle of life, seeking answers to who she was and who she is now. *"It's about being like a tree with all those rings around you, the layers of your life telling you who you were and where you've been,"* she says.

"I love origin stories," says the Vancouver musician. "I love finding out where people are and how they got there, so I'm constantly thinking about that. Everybody's carrying around their own narrative." Among the Evergreens is the revered Americana singer-songwriter's own narrative. Emerging under her own name in 2021 after retiring her long-time moniker, Oh Susanna, Among the Evergreens is Suzie's most personal album yet.

Imagery of the outdoors, of green valleys and trees shedding their leaves, infuses this new collection. It was written in America-born, Canada-raised Suzie's hometown of Vancouver, a city among the evergreens – the cherished place to which she returned after being lured by the thrill and promise of Toronto.

Suzie holds a Genie Award for Best Original Song, a Canadian Folk Music Award for Best Songwriter and is a three-time JUNO-nominee.
